Background

Scheduled for July 2007 is the adoption of new Technical Rules which are to lay down the obligations to fit AIS transponders on passenger and cargo ships in domestic trade of 300 gross tonnage and upwards (currently 27 passenger, 4 cargo ships) in line with Annex II-I of the Directive, whereas the mentioned Technical Rules will apply to new ships upon their entering into force, while with respect to existing ships those will be applicable by the date of accession of the Republic of Croatia to the European Union at the latest. Technical Rules, Part 16, 2007, pursuant to Directive, the fitting of VDR as well, with simultaneous introduction of the derogation option in line with the Directive 2002/59.

Project purpose.

For the purpose of this project it is considered that the AIS subsystem as a part of future VTMS is completed with AIS Main Control Centre in Rijeka MRCC and 17 AIS shore-based base stations.
